Accepted in LIMITED AMOUNTS

Only accepted in small quantities; as much as a wheelbarrow full. Must be in small containers that can be thrown away such as buckets, boxes, plastic tubs, heavy-duty bags, etc.

Only accepted on **Wednesdays & 3rd Saturdays**. Disposal fee: \$10 for up to 5 gallons. **Do not mix.**

Recycle & Disposal Fees

Automotive

Passenger Tires - Off Rim	\$5 each
Passenger Tires - On Rim	\$10 each
Truck Tires - Off Rim	\$10 each
Truck Tires - On Rim	\$20 each

- Extra-large or specialty tires will be assessed higher fees on an individual basis.
- Tires cannot be removed from the rim on-site.

Electronics

TVs/Monitors	\$10 each
Laptops/Tablets/Cell Phones	Free of Charge
Computers	Free of Charge
Printer/Scanner/Fax Machines	\$5 each
VCR/DVD/Bluray player	\$5 each
Stereo/Entertainment System	\$5 per piece
Small Electronics	\$5 per bag/box
CFLs/Fluorescent Tubes up to 4ft.	\$5 for up to 5 tubes
Fluorescent Tubes over 4ft.	\$10 for up to 5 tubes

- All televisions and monitors are accepted and charged the same price regardless of size or type (CRT/LCD/Plasma).
- Working condition of electronic items does not affect price.
- Small electronics includes keyboards, mice, video cards, modems, routers, small speakers, ink/toner cartridges, cell phones, chargers, cables, clock radios, CDs, DVDs, VHS tapes, etc.
- Fluorescent tubes and CFLs only. LED, incandescent, and other bulb types are not accepted.

Minimum Disposal Fee	\$5
Furniture	\$5 - \$20 each
Small Items	\$5 per box/bag
Pallets	\$5 for up to 2
Pickup Truck Load	\$5 - \$30 per load
6ft Trailer	\$30 - \$50
8ft Trailer	\$40 - \$70
10ft Trailer	\$50 - \$90
12ft Trailer	\$60 - \$120
14ft Trailer	\$70 - \$140
16ft Trailer	\$80 - \$160
18ft Trailer	\$90 - \$180
20ft Trailer	\$100 - \$200

- The minimum disposal fee covers any miscellaneous household items or debris not listed on this guide.
- Furniture is charged by the piece according to size.
- Twin/Single Mattresses - \$5
- Full/Queen/King Mattresses - \$10
- Couches - \$5 per seat
- Pickup truck loads filled to the sides of the bed are usually \$30.
- Price ranges for trailer sizes are for loads stacked up to 4ft in height. Trailer loads over 4ft in height may incur additional charges. Exact pricing depends on size and density of each load.

Yard Waste

Leaves & Grass Clippings	Free of Charge
Branches, Shrubs, & Plants	Free of Charge
Logs Under 6" Diameter	Free of Charge

- Leaves and grass clippings must be bagged.
- Must be separate from other materials to be free of charge.
- No dirt or soil will be accepted.
